IT'S WORTH WHILE BOOKING EARLY

We recommend that you book all your tickets using our online registration as soon as possible, as we have only a limited contingent available for each of the various events. We can not give any guarantee that, on the evening of the event, there will be enough tickets still for sale.

Please note the more detailed information in the online registration! There you will find buttons for the details and for direct bookings.

And this is how it works:

Booking using our online registration is as easy as this:

1. Log on to the online registration with your registration number and password.
2. In the overview lists, click on „Book“ next to the points you want, giving the required number of tickets in each price category, and finalize this procedure by a click on „Order“.
3. Change over to the finance section and select how you want to pay for your tickets.
