



ACCOMMODATION

During EuroGames the participants should be able to concentrate completely on the sport, the numerous cultural events and life in the city. For that reason there is a wide selection of accommodation in the program, from which everybody will find something suitable.

All accommodation offers can be booked at the online registration. Visitors of the EuroGames, not taking part at any sport event may register as visitor and book an accommodation as well as tickets for parties and cultural events.

The organizers have negotiated excellent prices for hotel rooms.

Hotels

Together with the agency Contour Travel Services in Munich the EuroGames have assembled a list of attractive hotels, in which everybody can find rooms to suit every budget. All prices are per person per night. Breakfast, service charge and taxes are included in the price. There is an additional charge for single rooms.

Category I, Economy hotels	38,00 €	(surcharge for single room: 22,00 €)
Category II, Middle class hotels	43,00 €	(surcharge for single room: 27,00 €)
Category III, Business hotels	48,00 €	(surcharge for single room: 32,00 €)
Category IV, Superior hotels	53,00 €	(surcharge for single room: 37,00 €)
Category V, Luxury hotels	58,00 €	(surcharge for single room: 52,00 €)

Only a category of hotel can be booked. A specific hotel can not be guaranteed by EuroGames. In general the organizers will book the centrally located hotels first. This means that those who book early will be sure of the best accommodation.

Conditions for cancellation

Should one has to cancel a confirmed reservation, the following charges will be due:

25 € per room up to 31st December 2003

50 € per room from 1st January to 31st May 2004

50% of the total amount from 1st to 30th June 2004

80% of the total amount from 1st July 2004 onwards

Hosted Housing

Those who would prefer to stay in a private room in the Munich „scene“ should apply for private accommodation, which will be made available without charge to the participants of EuroGames by the gays and lesbians of Munich.

In principle all participants may apply for private accommodation. Preferential treatment will be given to participants from the Outreach-Regions. The EuroGames will allocate the remaining private rooms on the „first come, first served“ principle. For this reason there is no guarantee for private accommodation during the games. However, everybody who applies for a private room will be informed in good time whether or not a room can be allocated - about two months before the games start. The organizers will then inform about the name of whoever will be welcoming the participant in Munich and where he/she will be staying. For this service a fee of 15,00 € will be charged. This money will go entirely towards the financing of EuroGames.

Bettenlager

In addition space will be provided in Munich in „Bettenlager“ (gymnasiums with a capacity of up to 180 places). The cost is 5,00 € per person per night. A light breakfast will also be available there; this is, however, not included in the price. For a stay in a „Bettenlager“ one will need to bring the own equipment, such as an Isomatte (foam underlay), sleeping bag or blankets.

Olympic Regatta Course

Single, double and dormitory rooms are available especially for the rowers and triathletes who wish to stay close to the sports venue. Breakfast, service charge and taxes are included in the price. A special shuttle service with buses between the station Feldmoching on the S- und U-Bahn and the Olympic Regatta Course will be arranged during the games. The S1 line of the S-Bahn connects the city center with the Munich Airport - it takes 15 minutes from the central rail station (Hauptbahnhof) to Feldmoching. The U2 line of the U-Bahn takes 17 minutes. The station Feldmoching is within the scope of the public transport ticket which all participants and visitors with the „La Ola“ package will receive when getting accredited. The Regatta Course can also easily be reached by car. It is only 300 m from the Oberschleißheim exit of the freeway A 92.

Single room: 24 € per night
Double room: 21 € per person per night
Dormitory (for 4-10 people): 18 € per person per night
